Resolution Recommending Local Historic Landmark Designation Faith Rock, ca 1782 Revolutionary War Incident

WHEREAS, Chapter 160A, Article 19, Part 3C of the North Carolina General Statutes provides for the designation of Local Historic Landmarks; and

WHEREAS, the Randolph County Historic Landmark Preservation Commission has taken into consideration all information in the Historic Landmark Designation Application and history submitted for the Faith Rock; and

WHEREAS, the N.C. Department of Cultural Resources, State Historic Preservation Office has been given the opportunity to review the historical data and commented that Faith Rock is worthy of landmark designation as the site of an event significant to the Revolutionary War history of Randolph County; and

WHEREAS, the Randolph County Historic Landmark Preservation Commission conducted the required public hearing, having published legal notices and mailings to adjoining property owners; and

WHEREAS, the Randolph County Historic Landmark Preservation Commission finds that the Faith Rock meets the following specific criteria outlined in the adopting Ordinance establishing the Commission: (1) Critical part of the County's heritage by having value as an event significant to the Revolutionary War history of Randolph County; and, (2) the location of the Faith Rock provides a unique and distinctive structure representing an established and familiar visual presence in Franklinville and Randolph County; and

WHEREAS, the property is more specifically described as follows:

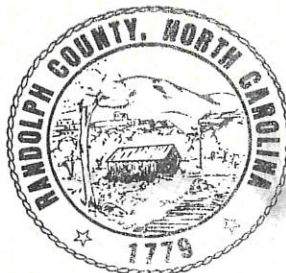
Faith Rock is located on a 1-acre site considered primary out of a 13.88 secondary tract, 216 W. Main Street, Franklinville Township, N.C., PIN# 7792258642, Owner, FBD Perry J. Conner IRA;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this 22nd day of October, 2013, that the Randolph County Historic Landmark Preservation Commission recommends to the Randolph County Board of Commissioners that the above referenced Faith Rock site be designated as a Randolph County Local Historic Landmark.
