Children: Dig into Reading

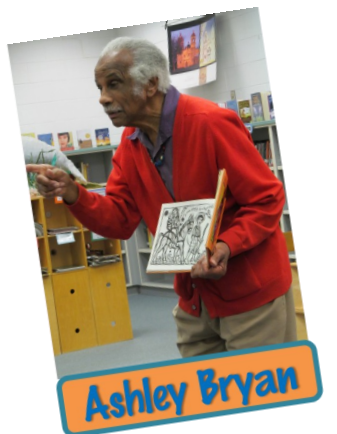
