Regional Coordinated Area Transportation System, RCATS, provides public transportation service to all Randolph and Montgomery County residents on an advanced reservation basis. Curb-to-Curb transportation services for older adults, persons with disabilities, human service agencies, and the general public are provided on a county-wide basis. Clean, dependable vans, some of which are equipped with special accessibility features, are used to transport passengers. Drivers are trained in First Aid, CPR, defensive driving and in other safety-related areas.

Scheduling:

All clients and individuals needing Rural Public
Transportation services should use the following
Schedule of Service Days and Appointment Times to
schedule their transportation needs for medical
appointments or other trips. All trip requests will be
honored on a space-available basis. Pick-up times will be
scheduled at the time you call to request your trip.

**All trip requests must be scheduled at least three working days in advance.

**Effective September 1, 2011 RCATS will set a weekly limit of 3 round trips per person. Trips included in this limit are "in-town" or "in-county", doctors appointments, grocery or drug store shopping trips, visitation, etc.
