NOTES

This is a transcription of an original record book donated to the Randolph County Public Library in 1993 by Mrs. Wade H. (Betty Burns) Page. The 10"x16" ledger book includes a leather spine and corners with cardboard covers, and is in poor condition. After the Civil War, the book came into the possession of Dr. Joseph John (J.J.) Hamlin (1828-1883), an Asheboro physician, who used the blank pages as his medical account book. Subsequently the book passed into the hands of T.A. Burns of Asheboro.

The original typescript transcription is in the files of William T. Auman in the Randolph Room of the Randolph County Public Library, Asheboro, N.C.
