#### NOTES

This is a transcription of an original record book donated to the Randolph County Public Library in 1993 by Mrs. Wade H. (Betty Burns) Page. The 10"x16" ledger book includes a leather spine and corners with carboard covers, and is in poor condition. After the Civil War, the book came into the possession of Dr. Joseph John (J.J.) Hamlin (1828-1883), an Asheboro physician, who used the blank pages as his medical account book. Subsequently the book passed into the hands of T.A. Burns of Asheboro.
